Mumbai, 7th Jun '18: Team of doctors at Fortis Hospital, Mulund handed out the health report cards amongst the Police officers of Mulund and Bhandup, today. These were based on a comprehensive health check and doctor consultations conducted for the Police force of Bhandup and Mulund. This event was graced by **Hon. Gautam Lakhmi, Additional Commissioner of Police (East region)** and **Hon. Akilesh Singh, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Zone-7**. The health report cards that were handed out to the Police force today, were based on screening of over 100 officers who underwent Blood Sugar Test, Lipid Profile, Complete Blood Count (CBC), Liver Function Test, Renal Function Tests, ECG and Chest X Rays. These were followed by doctor consultations to address dental and eye check-up's.

To honor the guardians of the community, in addition to the training and health checks, the hospital took the next step to adopt two Police stations, at Mulund and Bhandup. The Police force at these stations will be provided all health benefits at the hospital.
